

Prior to the start of the season, the BMHA Executive shall approve the Team Dress Code. It is the goal of the association for teams, coaches, executive members and volunteers to look professional and uniform both on and off the ice when representing our organization.

Therefore, the following Dress Code has been approved and is to be followed by all BMHA Representative teams for 2021-22 season.

- All Players through U11 will have the option to wear a dress shirt and tie, black dress pants, black dress shoes (or boots) and a Bulls team jacket, or a Bulls logo team warm up suit. Coaches' discretion at U11 and below – however, all team members must be dressed the same.
- All players U12 through U18 are required to wear a dress shirt and tie, black dress pants, black dress shoes (or boots) and a Bulls team jacket
- All Representative Coaches and bench staff are required to wear a dress shirt and tie, black dress pants, black dress shoes (or boots) and a Bulls team jacket.
- Trainers are an exception to this rule as they are expected to wear appropriate attire given their function ie. BMHA warm up-suit
- Female bench staff and players may substitute a shirt and tie with a blouse.
- Baseball caps are not permitted to be worn by coaches while in their dress attire • Toques will be permitted.
- During REP practices, On-Ice Team Staff shall be required to wear an approved BMHA warmup suit.
- Teams shall be permitted to wear approved BMHA warm-up suits at Tournaments provided the full team is in compliance.
