

All mandatory equipment must be worn during all games and practices.

All players, including goaltenders, shall wear a CSA approved hockey helmet to which a CSA approved hockey facial protector must be attached. Referees are not to start play if a player is on the ice without this protective equipment. For a first violation of this Regulation a warning will be issued to the team. The second violation will result in a Bench Minor Penalty being assessed against the offending team.

Should the helmet of a player come off while play is in progress, such player shall replace the helmet (properly fastened) or shall proceed to the player's bench for a substitution. If such a player participates in the play in any manner without his helmet, the play must be stopped immediately and the player assessed a Minor Penalty.

If a goaltender's helmet comes off, play is to be stopped immediately with no penalty to the goaltender unless the removal of the helmet was deliberate.

All players (including the back-up goaltenders) shall wear their helmets properly while sitting on their players' bench and penalty bench.

All players must wear a BNQ approved throat protector which is properly fastened around the neck in a manner such as to provide protection to the neck area at all times.

All goaltenders must wear a BNQ approved throat protector as stated in Regulation 17.4a) and they must wear a throat guard fastened in such a way as to protect the throat. (It may not be fastened in any manner that will void the CSA approval of the mask and/or helmet).

All OMHA players are required to wear a mouth guard while playing in games or practices. (See Policies and Procedures 2.4.4).

All BMHA Rep players are require to purchase a set of approved jerseys and socks (Home & Away).

All BMHA Rep Players will wear a Black CSA approved helmet and BMHA approved socks. In addition to the black helmet black hockey pants will also be mandatory for Rep players.

The primary colour of gloves for Rep players will also be black. Most have white on them and local stores sold gloves in Bulls colours in the past. As long as the main colour of the glove is black, coloured lettering, stitching or a white strip in my opinion would be acceptable.

The on-ice policy will be enforced.
